Wine List

White Wine

- 1. Five Foot Track Chardonnay** £21.50
Australia 125ml Glass £4.50
175ml Glass £5.90
Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel.

- 2. Malandrino Pinot Grigio** £24.50
Italy 125ml Glass £5.00
175ml Glass £6.40
The pale hue of the wine gives way to hints of perfume, pears, stone fruit and lime, as well as the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine.

- 3. Fathom's Sauvignon Blanc** £27.50
New Zealand 125ml Glass £5.50
175ml Glass £6.90
Typical of Kiwi Sauvignon, the bouquet springs from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. The palate is a burst of crisp grapefruit and gooseberry flavours.

Rosé Wine

- 4. Bois Des Violettes Rosé** £21.50
South of France 125ml Glass £4.50
175ml Glass £5.90
Bright and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and a refreshing dryness. The small proportion of Muscat adds a dash of juicy grapeyness.

Red Wine

- 5. Flor Del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon** £21.50
Chile 125ml Glass £4.50
175ml Glass £5.90
Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy-going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel.

- 6. Aires Andinos Malbec** £24.50
Argentina 125ml Glass £5.00
175ml Glass £6.40
Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish.

- 7. Torre Aldea Tinto, Rioja** £27.50
Spain 125ml Glass £5.50
175ml Glass £6.90
A deep bright red cherry colour with persistent aromas of ripe fruit and berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a wonderful aftertaste.

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

- 8. Prosecco Corte Alta NV, DOC** £29.95
Italy 125ml Glass £6.95
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.

- 9. J de Telmont Grande Réserve NV** £55.00
One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.
