



Visual story for  
travelling to the  
Theatre Royal and  
Royal Concert Hall  
Nottingham from  
Nottingham Train  
Station

The Theatre Royal and Royal Concert Hall is 0.7 miles from Nottingham Train Station.

Leave the train station through the glass doors labelled 'Exit to Station Street and City Centre'. There is a Starbucks opposite the glass doors.



Walk up Carrington Street, towards  
Broadmarsh shopping centre.



Enter Broadmarsh Shopping Centre





Walk through Broadmarsh shopping centre  
out onto Lister Gate.



Continue to walk up Lister Gate until you  
reach St Peter's Church and the Marks and  
Spencer.





Turn left onto Wheeler Gate



Continue to walk up Wheeler Gate until you reach the Market Square



From the Market Square, walk up Market Street.



The front of the Theatre Royal can be seen from the end of Market Street



Continue to walk up Market Street



Use the pedestrian crossings to cross Upper Parliament Street.



The entrance to the Theatre Royal is on  
Upper Parliament Street.



To get to the entrance of the Royal Concert  
Hall, walk down South Sherwood Street on  
the right hand side of the Theatre Royal.





You will walk past our Café bar, Yarn.
